A warm welcome to the new clubs entering this season.

All clubs please read this carefully as there are many differences to last season.

The league format is comprised of 8 zones and each team within that zone has three home games and three away games.

The winners of each of the 8 zones will automatically qualify for the round of 16.

If teams are equal on points then their position in the zone will be decided in the following order: shots scored, then fewest shots conceded and then by drawing of lots.

Thereafter, the next 8 clubs (from any zone) with the most shots scored will also qualify.

If teams have the same shots scored, then their position in the ranking will be decided in the following order: points obtained, then fewest shots conceded and then by drawing of lots.

Round of 16 matches will be played on 14th July starting at 18.15

Quarter finals will be played at Stoke Park on 21st July starting at 18.15

Semi finals will be played at Leatherhead on 28th July starting at 18.00

The final will be played on 4th August at Camberley starting at 17.30

League matches should commence at 18.15 p.m. All matches are open regarding gender.

Following national guidelines, the home team must offer two rinks or lots drawn to ensure fair play.

Toss of a coin to decide on the mat. Two up and two down in the trial ends.

Length of matches is 21 ends. It is important that matches go to 21 ends even if a team is being well beaten because shots scored are important. Two points for a win and 1 for a tie. Disputes can be resolved by noting information here, reading the competition rules on the WSBA website or discussing with the Match Sec.

### **PLEASE NOTE THE DETAILS BELOW REGARDING REPORTING OF RESULTS**

All results must be notified by the winning side (both teams if a tie) to the league secretary by email to:

The information required is as follows: Date, Zone number, full name of clubs (including whether A, B or C), score as per scorecard, first and last names of players in both teams. You may either type this out in your email or take a CLEAR photograph of the scorecard(s) and attach to the email.

Please retain your cards for future audit requirements.

Results of matches played on 7th July must be sent by email that evening. Teams failing to provide the required information as above may forfeit **2 points and 15 shots**. This will also apply to teams not fulfilling a match or without four players. In the case of clubs entering multiple teams, a player is only allowed to play in one of the teams in any one season.

NOTE: To qualify to play in the final stages a player must have played at least 2 games in the league stage of the competition unless a reason is lodged which is acceptable to the Match Secretary. It is therefore advisable that you have a squad with a couple of players in reserve. Matches called off due to adverse weather will need to be replayed on any mutually acceptable evening within two weeks or asap for the last two league matches. If you are unable to host a match for an avoidable reason, such as all your rinks are full, then the home side must liaise as early as possible with the opposition to play the match at the opponent's green. If this is not available, a neutral green. Please try your hardest to fulfil the fixtures.
