Winners A1 (H) v 3<sup>rd</sup> Place A3 (**A**); Winners A2 (H) v 3<sup>rd</sup> place A4 (**B**); 2<sup>nd</sup> place A1 (H) v 4<sup>th</sup> place A3 (**C**); 2<sup>nd</sup> place A2 (H) v 4<sup>th</sup> place A4 (**D**); 3<sup>rd</sup> place A1 v winners A3 (H) (**E**); 3<sup>rd</sup> place A2 v winners A4 (H) (**F**); 2<sup>nd</sup> place A4 (H) v 4<sup>th</sup> place A1 (**G**); 2<sup>nd</sup> place A3 (H) v 4<sup>th</sup> place A2 (**H**); (H) means home green. Letter in Bold in brackets is the game nomination for Quarter Finals.

Quarter Finals will be played at Stoke Park on 29th July commencing at 6.15 p.m. B v D (**A**); A v E (**B**); F v G (**C**); C v H (**D**)

Semi Finals will be played at Old Dean on 5th August commencing at 6.00 p.m. C v B; D v A.

Final will be played at Egham on 12th August commencing at 5.30 p.m.

### **PLEASE NOTE THE DETAILS BELOW REGARDING REPORTING OF RESULTS**

All results must be notified by the WINNING side to the league secretary by email to:

[wbsamidweekfridayeveningleague@gmail.com](mailto:wbsamidweekfridayeveningleague@gmail.com) within **24** hours of the match completion.

The information required is as follows: Full name of clubs (including whether A or B), score as per scorecard (s); first and last names and positions of players in both teams. You may either type this out in your email or take a CLEAR photograph of the scorecard(s) and attach to the email. Please retain your cards for future audit requirements.

Results of matches played on 15th July must be sent by email that evening. Teams failing to provide the required information as above may forfeit 2 points and 10 shots. This will also apply to teams without four players. In the case of clubs entering multiple teams, a player is only allowed to play in one of the teams in any one season.

NOTE: To qualify to play in the final stages a player must have played at least 2 games in the league stage of the competition unless a reason is lodged which is acceptable to the League committee. It is therefore advisable that you have a squad with a couple of players in reserve.

Matches called off due to adverse weather will need to be replayed on any mutually acceptable evening within two weeks or asap for the last two league matches. If you are unable to host a match for an avoidable reason, such as all your rinks are full, then the home side must liaise as early as possible with the opposition to play the match at the other green. Please try your hardest to fulfil the fixtures.

Please note that there are new rules for the Friday Evening League this season. The Committee reserve the right to make necessary decisions about incidents and outcomes to ensure smooth running of the league and final stages.
